Programmes and Activities

Voluntary Teaching in Slums

Voluntary Teaching Programme of SAMAR in slums of Patna is being run for 4-5 years now. It started from a small slum in Mahesh Nagar, near Patliputra Colony. Now there are three big slums where we are working. Taking a big leap this year, we have hired the services of **educationist and Social Activist Mr. Uday Pratap Singh.** Now the work is going in a professional manner. He is at present preparing the profiles of all the children who are associated with us in slums. The profiling will contain all the details of children that will shed light on the economic and social background of those children. Also their educational capabilities will be known to us. This will help us in improving the learning achievement of each children in coming days.

In an attempt to enlarge the envelope of voluntary teaching, we have had a series of talks with government schools. We are building relationship with the teachers of Primary Schools. For a beginning, a session of Origami was conducted at a primary school in Indrapuri, Patna recently. This process if continues for a longer period then it will bear fruits.

We have expanded our work this year. A new centre has come up at Mangal Akhara, Patna City with the help of engineers and employees of Electricity department. Mr. Mazhar Hussain a junior engineer in Electricity Department is the key person in this initiative. Now we are working in four slums. Theses slums are –

- Indrapuri
- Rajiv Nagar
- Adalatghat, Bankipur
- Mangal Akhara, Patna City

We hope our reach to slums will increase in coming years.

Art and Culture

This year a new initiative by SAMAR members has been rolled out – Community Jamming. Azmi is spearheading this musical inititative. Under this initiative Azmi has conducted Busking – *the activity of playing music in the street or another public place for voluntary donations* – which helped SAMAR to spread message and raise funds also. We hope next year the initiative will flourish.

Summer Camp

In this activity year SAMAR organised an activity camp for children of Kamla Nehru School, Patliputra Colony, Patna. The camp engaged the children for five days in various interesting activities like – Story Telling, Film Show, Mask making, Origami, theatre games etc. The purpose of the camp was to inculcate various skills of Art and various values of life in the school going children. The method of joyful learning made it not only interesting but successful also. Some 40 children participated in the camp.

Research and Development

In activity year of 2017-18, we conducted a study on slums. We hope this study will enhance our knowledge of Urban Poverty and Unorganised Labour Community. We hope the study will be com this calendar year. We have given the first draft of the report to Rahul Yaduka –

We have given the first draft of the report to Rahul Yaduka – a PhD scholar in Delhi for proof reading. At present, report sheds light on demography of slum dwellers, educational status of head of family of each families surveyed, caste break up and status of welfare schemes in slum areas.

This report is a painstaking job of two young volunteers of SAMAR – Furquan and Zaheeb.

Flood Relief Work

A devastating flood rocked the northern parts of Bihar in July – August 2017. Some districts were severely affected like Madhepura and Supaul. SAMAR carried a relief works in these districts through friends working in those flooded areas. We distributed about 1000 kgs of rice among flood affected people. In Supaul, bleaching powder was distributed in order to control the spread of any epidemic among villagers. SAMAR also mobilised donations to distribute warm clothes among children in Supaul. These children live with their families on a land surrounded by water bodies from four sides like an island. Every year during flood, they get displaced and get deprived with their basic needs. SAMAR came like Man Friday for those childen.
